APA Signing

The Annual Performance Agreement (APA) signing ceremony between the Ministry of Public Administration (MOPA) and BPATC take place in 26th June 2022 in the Secretariat, Dhaka. On behalf of the MOPA, Senior Secretary Mr. K M Ali Azam and from BPATC Mr. Ramendra Nath Biswas, Rector (Secretary to the Government) signed the agreement. Other ground officials both from the MOPA and BPATC were also present in the program. Multifarious targets, performance appraisal indicators were set by the APA of 2022-23 (Financial Year) to upgrade BPATC's contribution and performance in the area of training, research and consultancy than the preceding years.

Reconstitution of the Innovation Team of BPATC

The centre of excellence has an Innovation Team which is mainly appointed to execute and implement the innovation ideas, e-governance related enterprise of the centre. In the manual of APA, innovation and e-governance got grave significance. Under the guidance of Rector, the Innovation Team of BPATC was reconstituted on 15th June 2022. A special Training of Trainers (ToT) was organized at BPATC from 21 to 23 June of 2022. This program was mainly a joint collaboration of the SSGP (Support to Sustainable Graduation Project) of Economic Relations Division (ERD) of the Ministry of Finance Division and BPATC. A total of thirty participants from the renowned training institutes of Bangladesh such as BPATC, BCS Administration Academy, BIAM Foundation, Dhaka, NAPD and ERD participated in that training. The nomination of the participants was done by the ERD, and SSGP did the required funding. The focus or aim of that special ToT was to develop a team of specialist trainer on Bangladesh's Graduation from LDC category as this issue is going to be a key subject for policies in coming years. Experts from

the concerned area and experienced resource persons facilitated all the training sessions to make the ToT effective. Seniors officials from BPATC, ERD and SSGP attended the opening and closing ceremonies of the ToT to inspire the participants and convey the core message and objectives of organizing such a special training program.

After completing all the required phases of the recruitment (i.e., viva-voce, demonstration, verification), BPATC got eight new faculty members for its service for the coming years.
